18 support of this Application and previously in this action, and *the terms of*  
19 the Temporary Restraining Order issued by this Court on November 10, 2009 restrain and enjoin Defendants  
20 Qiani Nou ("Nou") and Ed Meyer ("Meyer") from selling, renting, licensing, exhibiting,  
21 disclosing, distributing, disseminating, publishing, broadcasting or otherwise exploiting for  
22 monetary gain or attempting to sell, rent, license, exhibit, distribute, disseminate, license,  
23 publish, broadcast or otherwise exploit for monetary gain the Home Video Materials and  
24 Proposed Film Materials, as defined in the TRO and OSC, the Court finds that this *Sealing Order*  
25 *Code of Civil Procedure § 527 and and 3.1703(a).*  
26 is appropriate pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rules 2.550 *et seq*. Among other things, the  
27 Court finds as follows:

- 28 (1) There exists an overriding interest that overcomes the right of public access to the record;
- (2) The overriding interest supports sealing the record;
- (3) A substantial probability exists that the overriding interest will be prejudiced if the record is not sealed;
- (4) The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored; and

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(5) No less restrictive means exist to achieve the overriding interest.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
