This cause came to be heard upon Plaintiff's Complaint for Divorce and the Defendant's Grounds of Defense filed in response thereto; upon the depositions of witnesses on behalf of Plaintiff, after notice of same having been waived by Defendant, duly taken before a notary public, and was argued by counsel.

UPON CONSIDERATION WHEREOF, it appearing to the Court independently of the admissions of either party in the pleadings or otherwise that Plaintiff and Defendant were lawfully married on the 18TH day of May, 2002, in Henrico County, Virginia; that one (1) child was born of the marriage, namely Ayden Scott Levitin, born December 16, 2002; that Plaintiff and Defendant last cohabited as husband and wife in Henrico County, Virginia, in September 2005; that both parties are domiciled in and have been bona fide residents of the Commonwealth of Virginia for more than six months next preceding the commencement of this suit; that both parties are of sound mind, are over the age of 18 years, and neither of them is in the military service of the United States; that the parties have lived separate and apart for more than one year, that is, since September 2005, without any cohabitation and without interruption and no reconciliation has taken place or is probable; that at the time of the parties' separation in September of 2005, it

was their intent to obtain a final decree of divorce; that all matters pertaining to custody and support of the infant child of the parties, Ayden Scott Levitin, have been previously adjudicated by the Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court of the City of Richmond, Virginia, and this Court takes no jurisdiction over this issue; that subsequent to the parties' separation, the parties have entered into an agreement dated the 5th day of September 2007 concerning support and maintenance, property division and other matters related to the marriage, a copy of which having been previously filed herein; it is therefore


ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED that Plaintiff be, and he is hereby granted a divorce *a vinculo matrimonii* from Defendant pursuant to §20-91(9) of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended; and it is further


