

DECLARATION OF TERI JOHNSON

I, TERI JOHNSON, hereby declare the following:

1. I am over 18 years of age, and a resident of Des Moines, Iowa.

2. I am the mother and Guardian of Shawn Johnson.

3. On or about March 23, 2009 there was an incident that occurred at CBS Studios, where my daughter was located preparing to tape a television show.

4. A person now known as Robert O'Ryan was attempting to contact my daughter. No one knew who this person was so he was detained by CBS Security while they waited for the LAPD to arrive at the studio Dave Williams had the time to conduct a brief interview.

5. It was extremely disturbing to us that this person had so much information on my daughter life.

6. After the LAPD arrived they conducted their own interview of him and he made the following statements: he had packed all his belongings and permanently left Florida to drive out here to be with my daughter, he believes that she speaks with him personally through the television set and through ESP and that they will have a child together, he stated he would be with her no matter what.

7. Later the LAPD had the occasion to search his automobile and they discovered numerous disturbing items along with loaded guns, duct tape, zip ties, and lots of memorabilia on my daughter.

2 8. This incident has caused us severe emotional distress,  
3 we have been on the move ever since and have not been able to rest  
4 at all for fear that this disturbed person will attempt to make good  
5 on his statements and attempt to harm my daughter and possibly us as

4 1. I am over 18 years of age, and a resident of Los

6 2. I am an officer with the Culver City Police Department.

7 3. On or about March 23, 2009 I was acting in the capacity  
8 of a Private Security Officer for CBS Studios.

9 4. I had the opportunity to speak with the Respondent  
10 prior to the arrival of the LAPD on the scene.

11 5. I asked him how he knew the Petitioner and he stated  
12 that he knew her through ESP.


13 6. He stated that he had been following her actions since

**Narrative:**

On Monday, March 23, 2008 at approximately 1545hrs, Mr. Terry James, (CBS Video Tape Technician ext. 2241), advised Main Gate Security Officer Antonio Wagner that he had witnessed an unknown person jump over the fence, north of Circle Drive.

Officer Wagner immediately contacted P.O. Roy via radio and advised him to proceed to his location. Upon doing so, he made P/O Roy aware of a possible trespasser. P/O Roy acknowledged and contacted S-3, S-2 and all P.O.'s. It was then stated that the unknown male subject was a white male, 30's, a beard, wearing a white shirt and black hat.

S-3 Jorge Sosa responded to the East Studio with P.O. Roy, to conduct a thorough search. We were joined by S-3 Rito and S-2 Horace. We initiated both interior and exterior checks. DWTS P/O's Frank Gamboa and P.O. Dave Williams were contact and made aware of the subject in question. Within minutes, it was determined that a male individual was seen in the hallway of the East Studio.

P/O Williams and Gamboa approached the subject and proceeded to question his business at CBS. The subject identified himself as Mr. Robert O'ryan and stated that he was here to meet with Ms. Shauna Johnson. At that moment, Officer Dave Williams asked Robert how he obtained clearance onto the property. Mr. Robert O'ryan openly admitted that he had jumped the fence located north of circle drive. Robert O'ryan was immediately escorted to the South side of the East Studio.

I asked Officer Carmen if she had seen the individual. Security Officer Carmen advised me that the suspect had been trying to gain access into the Studio. He was informed that a proper clearance would be needed if he were to gain access into the DWTS stage. Robert O'ryan explained to Officer Carmen that he was here to see Shauna Johnson, a celebrity

contestant on Dancing with the Stars.

Officer Carmen notified a Production Assistant if he can get a clearance for Robert O'ryan. Upon investigation Officer Carmen was notified that Shauna Johnson did not know Robert O'ryan. Robert than said that he was here for Steve-O, also a celebrity contestant on DWTS. Upon further investigation Officer Carmen was notified that no one in Steve-o's group knew who he was.

Once located in stage 36 holding area, we began to question Mr. O'ryan. He told us that he had driven from Florida, in the hopes of being able to meet Shauna Johnson. He advised us that he was a fan and that he wanted to meet her. Mr. O'ryan seemed obsessed by Ms. Johnson. P.O. Dave asked Mr. O'ryan where his vehicle was located, he advised us that his vehicle was parked out the Farmer's Market next to the Gilmore Bank.

The only identification located on Mr., O'ryan's person was a concealed weapon license from Florida, CA, which was expired. Officer Dave asked Mr. O'ryan if he had any weapons on his person. He responded by saying that he did not have any weapons on him, but he had a shotgun and Colt 45 hand gun in his vehicle. He advised us that he was driven a Gold 2001 Honda Accord.

S-3 Rito Sigala contacted LAPD Wilshire regarding a "Trespasser and possible weapons in a his vehicle. LAPD arrived at approximately 1700. LAPD Officer's Maldonado, Goldberg and Detective Ruffalo responded to the call.

At LAPD's request, representatives of Shauna Johnson would need to sign a form regarding Mr. O'ray possibly stalking her. Cheryl Shae and Ashley Ashton (Shauna Johnson's representatives) were present and interviewed. In addition, LAPD also met and interviewed representatives of Steve-O. Frank Gamboa advised the LAPD of what he had stated regarding possible stalking and weapons in his personal vehicle. Mr. Wayne Wyman, CBS Director of Facilities, along with Mr. August Messana was also present.

LAPD confirmed the information with Mr. O'ryan and stated that Mr. O'ryan would cooperate with LAPD. LAPD stated that given the circumstances, they would contact the LAPD Bomb Squad to search his personal vehicle and search his room at the Tarzan Inn. LAPD officers departed CBS property via genesse at approximately 1855hrs.

Photos of the subject were taken. It was unclear as to LAPD's findings, as it was off CBS property. Currently, he is being held by LAPD Wilshire Division on a 72 hour hold. The arresting # 090708453.
