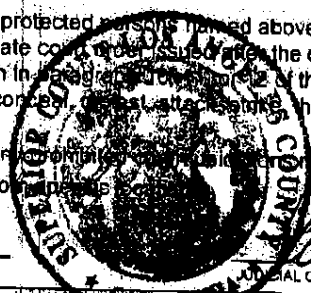

For good cause shown, the court grants the protected persons named above the exclusive care, possession, and control of the following animals: _____

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, THE COURT ORDERS THAT THE ABOVE-NAMED DEFENDANT

- must not harass, strike, threaten, assault (sexually or otherwise), follow, stalk, molest, destroy or damage personal or real property, disturb the peace, keep under surveillance, or block movements of the protected persons named above.
- must surrender to local law enforcement or sell to a licensed gun dealer any firearm owned or subject to his or her immediate possession or control within 24 hours after service of this order and must file a receipt with the court showing compliance with this order within 48 hours of receiving this order.**
- must not attempt to or actually prevent or dissuade any victim or witness from attending a hearing or testifying or making a report to any law enforcement agency or person.
- must take no action to obtain the addresses or locations of protected persons or their family members, caretakers, or guardian unless good cause exists otherwise. The court finds good cause not to make the order in item 9.
- must have no personal, electronic, telephonic, or written contact with the protected persons named above.
- must have no contact with the protected persons named above through a third party, except an attorney of record.
- must not come within 50 yards *which will be reduced to 10 yards in the event* of the protected person *and defendant are in attendance at same event* of the protected person.
- may have peaceful contact with the protected persons named above only for the safe exchange of children for court-ordered visitation as stated in the attached Family, Juvenile, or Probate court order in Case No. _____ issued on _____ this order, as an exception to the "no-contact" or "stay-away" provision in paragraph 10, 11, or 12 of this order.
- may have peaceful contact with the protected persons named above only for the safe exchange of children for visitation as stated in a Family, Juvenile, or Probate court order issued after the date this order is signed, as an exception to the "no-contact" or "stay-away" provision in paragraph 10, 11, or 12 of this order.
- must not take, transfer, encumber, conceal, or otherwise dispose of the animals described in paragraph 5.
- The protected persons may record and disseminate any audio or video made by the restrained person.
