Re: Jay Jessup Photogon

Dear Mr. Collins,

At your request, a polygraph examination was administered to, the subject (Jay Photogon) on 3-21-09, to determine whether the subject had in fact threatened Gretchen Rossi sometime between midnight 2-17-09 and 1am on 2-18-09 and again on March 4, 2009.

During the subject's (Jay Photogon) pre-test interview, the subject stated that he did not intentionally call Gretchen Rossi on March 4, 2009. Furthermore, the subject denied threatening to harm Ms. Gretchen Rossi, her dog or her friend Stacy Smiley. Nor did the subject threaten to harm himself in Gretchen Rossi's bedroom.

Two control questions were also included on this Modified General Question Test (MGQT) as approved by two National polygraph organizations and the U. S. Army's Polygraph school. A 4-Channel Lafayette polygraph instrument was used to record the subject's cardio/pulse responses, upper and lower respiration and electrodermal skin conductance tracings. The instrument was calibrated to factory standards on the morning of this examination and all functions were satisfactory.

The polygraph examination was broken down into two-separate examinations of 5-questions in each polygraph examination.

The subject was asked the following relevant questions during the polygraph examination:

Examination I:

(1) On March 4, 2009, did you threaten to harm Gretchen Rossi?  
Answer: NO

(2) On March 4, 2009, did you threaten to strangle Gretchen Rossi?  
Answer: NO

(3) On March 4, 2009, did you threaten to dispose of Slade Smiley?  
Answer: NO

(4) On March 4, 2009, did you threaten to bang yourself in Gretchen Rossi's bedroom?  
Answer: NO

(5) On March 4, 2009, did you threaten to kill Gretchen Rossi's dogs?  
Answer: NO

**Examination III:**

(1) Between midnight on 2-17-09 and 2-18-09, did you intentionally dial Gretchen Rossi's phone number?  
Answer: YES

(2) During this call with Gretchen Rossi, did you make any threats to harm Gretchen Rossi?  
Answer: NO

(3) Did you make this phone call with the intention of playing a song that had sentimental value to you?  
Answer: YES

(4) During this phone call, did you speak to Gretchen Rossi?  
Answer: NO

(5) On March 4, 2009, did you intentionally dial Gretchen Rossi's phone number?  
Answer: NO

**Conclusion:**

After carefully reviewing the polygraph charts from both examinations of *Examination I & Examination II*, it is the opinion of this examiner, that there was NO indication of deception regarding the relevant questions during the polygraph examination.
