INFORMATION SUMMARY: DO NOT INCLUDE INFORMATION WHICH MAY LATER BE PERTINENT TO THE CASE.

On March 20, 2010, at approximately 2140 hours, a fatal traffic collision occurred at the intersection of Olympic Boulevard and Beverly Glen Boulevard. A 35 year old male resident of Los Angeles, riding a motorcycle was travelling westbound on Olympic Boulevard when he collided with a 2006 Land Rover travelling eastbound on Olympic Boulevard to northbound Beverly Glen Boulevard. The motorcycle collided with the passenger side of the Land Rover and the male rider subsequently collided with the roadway.

The Los Angeles City Fire Department responded to the scene and pronounced the motorcyclist dead at 2150 hours. The male's identity is being withheld pending notification to his next of kin. The driver of the Land Rover, Caleigh Anne Forsythe-Peters, a 21 year old resident of Beverly Hills, was not injured.

The preliminary investigation revealed the primary cause of the collision was 22350 VC, unsafe speed on the part of the motorcyclist. No other crime was involved in this collision.

Officer Pheng, Serial No. 37849, West Traffic Division, conducted the on scene investigation. West Traffic Division Detectives will conduct the follow up investigation.
