



22 1. I am a member of the Bar of the State of California, and eligible to appear in all

1 2. I have personal knowledge of each of the facts herein, except those set forth on
2 information and belief and, as to those matters, I believe them to be true. If called as a witness, I
3 could and would testify competently with respect to such facts.

4 3. On March 14, 2008, Siemens Financial initiated an action against Global
5 Cardiovascular Associates ("Global") and Conrad Murray ("Murray") (collectively, "Judgment
6 Debtors"), to recover amounts owed to Siemens Financial under an equipment lease and personal
7 guaranty, respectively, in the District Court of Nevada, Clark County captioned *Siemens Financial*
8 *Services, Inc. v. Global Cardiovascular Associates, et al.*, Case No. A559118.

9 4. On February 8, 2010, summary judgment was entered in favor of Siemens Financial
10 and against the Judgment Debtors. On February 19, 2010, a Judgment was entered by the District
11 Court, Clark County, Nevada in the above referenced case against: (1) Judgment Debtor Global
12 Cardiovascular Associates ("Global") in the amount of \$232,239.68, plus attorneys' fees and costs
13 in the amount of \$42,919.10, plus reasonable attorneys' fees and costs incurred in collection of the
14 Judgment and post-judgment interest; and (2) Judgment Debtor Conrad Murray, M.D. ("Murray")
15 in the amount of \$69,671.90, plus attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$42,919.10, plus
16 reasonable attorneys' fees and costs incurred in collection of the Judgment and post-judgment
17 interest (the "Judgment"). The Judgment is in all things final, valid, subsisting, and unsatisfied.

18 5. Concurrent with the filing of this Declaration, Siemens Financial is demonstrating
19 the Judgment with the above entitled Court and a Case Number will be assigned to this matter.

20 6. No amounts have been paid to date on the Judgment.

21 7. Interest has accrued from the date of the Judgment to the present for Global at the
22 contract rate of 1.3% per month of the principal amount owed as of February 4, 2009 (\$197,675.88)
23 or 85.66 per day ($.013/30 \times \$197,675.88$). The amount of interest that has accrued from February
24 9, 2010 through March 7, 2011 is \$33,493.06 or $\$85.66 \times 391$ days.

25 8. Interest has accrued from the date of the Judgment to the present for Murray at the
26 contract rate of 30% of all amounts owed by Global or \$10,047.92 ($\$33,493.06 \times 0.30$).

27 9. There is actually remaining due on the Judgment the following amounts:

1 (a) for Global, the sum of \$232,239.68, plus \$39,136.85 in attorneys' fees, plus
2 \$3,782.25 in costs, plus the sum of \$33,493.06 in accrued interest, plus the filing fee
3 domesticating the Judgment with the above entitled Court in the amount of \$395.00, for a
4 total Judgment of \$309,046.84, plus \$85.66 interest per day accruing from the date of this
5 Declaration, plus post-judgment attorneys' fees and costs incurred, for which sum it is
6 prayed that a writ of execution be issued in the above entitled action in favor of Plaintiff
7 Siemens Financial Services, Inc., and against Judgment Debtor Global Cardiovascular
8 Associates. Upon entry of the domesticated Judgment and issuance of the writ of
9 execution, interest shall accrue on the judgment at the rate of 10% per annum on the
