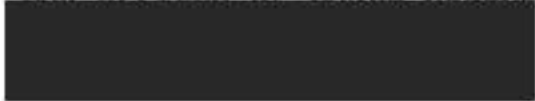

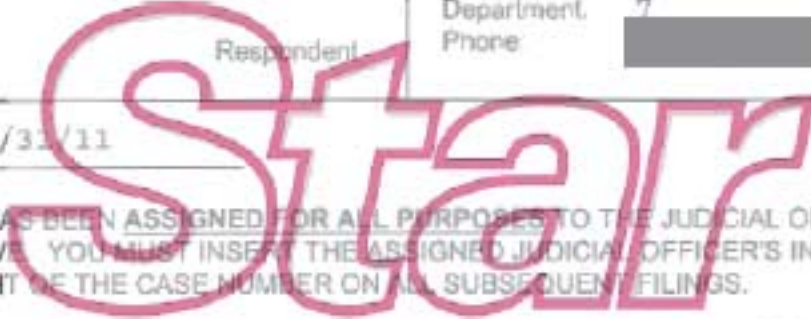



19 I, Mariah Yeater, do hereby state and declare as follows:

20 1. I am over the age of 18 and competent to testify as to the following facts, which are of my  
21 own personal knowledge.

22 2. On the night of October 25, 2010, I attended a Justin Bieber concert at the Staples Center in  
23 Los Angeles, California. I was 19 years old at the time and was near the front row at the concert.

1           3. Immediately following the concert I was approached by a security guard who asked if I  
2 wanted to meet Justin Bieber backstage. I accepted the invitation and followed him backstage.

3           4. After waiting for a short period of time with several other young women, Justin Bieber  
4 appeared and engaged me in conversation. Immediately, it was obvious that we were mutually attracted  
5 to one another, and we began to kiss. Shortly thereafter, Justin Bieber suggested that I go with him to a  
6 private place where we could be alone. I agreed to go with him and on the walk to a private area in the  
7 Staples Center he told me he wanted to make love to me and that this was going to be his first time. He  
8 also said he would give me his phone number after we had sex and told me he wanted me to be at his  
9 future concerts too and he would give me backstage passes.

10          5. After walking away from the other people backstage, Justin Bieber found a place where we  
11 could be alone – a bathroom. We went inside and immediately his personality changed drastically. He  
12 began touching me and repeatedly said he wanted to fuck the shit out of me. At that time I asked him to  
13 put on a condom for protection but he insisted that he did not want to. In his own words, he said that  
14 because it was his first time he wanted to feel everything.

15          6. Justin Bieber then quickly took off my clothes, and we had sex. He was on top of me with  
16 my legs around him. At the time I was on top of some type of shelf. The sexual intercourse itself was  
17 brief, lasting only approximately 30 seconds.

18          7. After Justin Bieber came inside me he was clearly embarrassed about how the sex did not  
19 last very long. He immediately put on his clothes and blew me off when I asked about seeing him again.  
20 I asked him for his private phone number, but he insisted on taking my phone number. We had no paper  
21 or anything to write it down on, and Justin Bieber was clearly not interested in getting his cell phone or  
22 any paper. He said he would just remember the number, which I told him.

23          8. When I later realized I was pregnant with Justin Bieber's baby I tried to contact him through  
24 his representatives but no one ever called me back.

1           9. On July 6, 2011, I gave birth to a baby boy. That was exactly 36 weeks and 2 days after the  
2 sexual encounter with Justin Bieber. Based upon the timing as well as the fact that there were no other  
3 possible men that I had sex with that could be the father of this baby, I believe that Justin Bieber is in  
4 fact the father of my baby.

5           10. I am now requesting that Justin Bieber be compelled to undergo a paternity test to  
6 scientifically confirm that he is in fact the father of my baby. I also request that he provide adequate  
7 child support for my baby.

8           I swear under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America and the laws

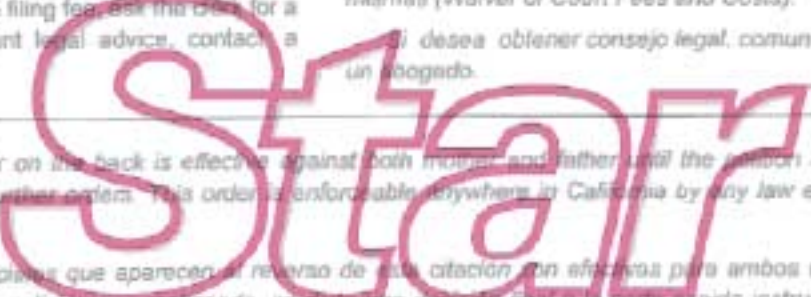
