



23 IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Plaintiff, Nevada State Bank ("Plaintiff") shall  
24 recover of and from Defendants, NICOLAS CAGE, individually, and NICOLAS CAGE as  
25 TRUSTEE OF THE AMENDED AND RESTATED NICOLAS CAGE TRUST AGREEMENT,  
26 RICHARD HUME, as TRUSTEE OF THE HANCOCK PARK REAL ESTATE TRUST (herein  
27 collectively as "Defendants"), jointly and severally, \$2,300,145.24 in principal and interest  
28 accrued as of May 31, 2010 (at the contract rate of 2.5% until April 25, 2009 default and then

1 5.5% post-default) with interest continuing to accrue thereon at the contract rate of 5.5% until  
2 entry of the Judgment (\$186.49 per diem), delinquent taxes paid by Plaintiff at foreclosure of  
3 \$106,811.49, foreclosure costs of \$35,213.90, \$24,722.72 in attorneys' fees, legal costs of  
4 \$9,915.22, and interest accruing thereon at the contract rate of 5.5% upon the total amount upon  
5 entry of Judgment until the Judgment is paid in full.
