Warnings and Notices to the Restrained Person in ②

You Cannot Have Guns or Firearms

You cannot own, have, possess, buy or try to buy, receive or try to receive, or otherwise get a gun while this Order is in effect. If you do, you can go to jail and pay a \$1,000 fine. You must sell to a licensed gun dealer or turn in to police any guns or firearms that you have or control in accordance with item ⑧ above. The court will require you to prove that you did so. If you do not obey this Order, you can be charged with a crime.

ATTACHMENT "A" TO CH-100*Seagal v. Bates*

[Petitioner's Additional Factual Summary and Memorandum of Points and Authorities In Support of His Petition/Application for Orders Prohibiting Harassment]

FACTUAL SUMMARY

1. Petitioner Steven Seagal ("Mr. Seagal" and/or "Petitioner") respectfully submits this factual summary and memorandum of Points and Authorities in Support of his Petition and Request for Orders Prohibiting Harassment against Respondent Angela Rain Bates ("Bates" and/or "Respondent").
2. Although Mr. Seagal is a world-famous and theatrical motion picture and television actor and producer, he is entitled, like any citizen, to be free of intrusion, harassment and stalking from an obsessed and mentally unstable delusional and violent person. Petitioner does not personally know nor have any relationship with Bates, has never spoken with her nor initiated personal contact of any type with her, nor does he desire any interaction or communication with her what-so-ever. (Seagal Decl., ¶4).
3. Bates, an apparent delusional schizophrenic, is an obsessed mentally ill stalker, who believes she is married to Petitioner's father, who is deceased, is a member of Petitioner's family, and that she has resided at Petitioner's residence for the past twenty-years. Bates has compulsively sought to have personal contact with Mr. Seagal and insert herself into Petitioner's and his families' personal and private lives. (Jackson Decl., ¶7, 10-15; Seagal Decl. ¶¶4-5). Most recently in her on-going harassment and stalking, Bates was arrested on July 14th, 2010 after she trespassed at Petitioner's property, and, when confronted, vandalized his home and physically attacked Petitioner's employee. (Jackson Decl., Exh "A"; Seagal Decl. ¶¶8-9; Zhe Decl. ¶¶4-6).
4. As evidenced by Bates's obsession with Petitioner, and Bates's compulsive on-going stalking of Petitioner and his family, and unwanted and unsolicited attempted communications and contact, including her recent laying-in-wait out side Petitioner's home for an opportunity to gain access, and her various delusional and irrational statements, the nature of Bates's conduct has become much more alarming and her motivation and obsession have become more ominous,

1 intrusive and extremely threatening. Bates has committed on-going acts of stalking against
2 Petitioner, in a knowing and willful course of conduct directed at him and his family, which has
3 and is seriously alarming, annoying and/or harassing him, and that serves no legitimate purpose.

4 5. As set forth in this Application and the accompanying Declaration of Steven Seagal
5 ("Seagal Decl."), the Declaration of LAPD Threat Management Unit Detective Christine Jackson
6 ("Jackson Decl.") and the Declaration of Zong Zhe ("Zhe Decl."), as well as the statements and
7 admissions of Bates herself, Bates has engaged in wrongful acts of harassment, stalking and
8 implied threats of violence against Petitioner and his family, and made express statements
9 indicating that unless restrained the conduct is very likely not only to continue, but also to escalate
10 and cause further harassment, including potentially physical harm to Petitioner's family.

11
12 **Current Delusional Schizophrenia and/or Mental Illness**

13 6. Bates suffers from mental illnesses, including apparently from delusional
14 schizophrenia. Bates has stated that she believes that she personally knows Petitioner and his
15 family, and that she is a member of that family. (Jackson Decl., ¶7). For examples, Bates
16 nonsensically believes that she married "Steven Seagal Sr.," the incorrect name she used to refer
17 to Petitioner's father, in 1970 in Toronto, Canada, when she and Petitioner's father were both 16
18 1/2 years old -- when Mr. Seagal himself would have been approximately 18-years-old. Bates,
19 born England, and later living in Toronto, Canada, believes that her "husband", referring to
20 Petitioner's father, worked as a policeman in Toronto and was able to get her Canadian citizenship
21 as a gift. Bates, stated that her "maiden" name was "Bates," but falsely believes that her legal
22 name is "Angela Seagal". Despite that Petitioner's father's passed-away almost twenty-years-ago,
23 Bates delusionally states that she lived with her husband in the residence, *i.e.*, Petitioner's
24 residence, until the time when she went on holiday less than two-years-ago, and that she and her
25 husband are the true owners of the house. Bates further states that she has had no contact with her
26 "husband" for a long time, approximately 18 months, stating that she had gone away on a holiday,
27 and has not been able to see or talk to her husband "since" her return. (*Id.*, ¶7-10).

28 ///

1 **Multi-Year Escalating Fixation with and Stalking of Seagal and His Family**

2 7. Bates obsession has included an on-going delusional compulsion in which she has
3 repeatedly sought to have personal contact with and insert herself into Petitioner's families' lives.
4 Since at least early-2009, Bates has admittedly pursued and engaged in a pattern of conduct of
5 harassment and stalking directed at Petitioner and his family, including leaving multiple telephone
6 messages and sending multiple written letters to Petitioner, and showing-up at his home on at least
7 three occasions, ultimately laying-in-wait outside Petitioner's home for an opportunity to gain
8 access to the residence. And, after seizing such an opportunity, Bates trespassed at Petitioner's
9 residence and vandalized his home, and physically attacked his employee when she was denied
10 access to Petitioner and his home. (Jackson Decl., ¶11-14; Seagal Decl. ¶¶4-9; Zhe Decl. ¶4-7).
11 Bates's conduct constitutes stalking, harassment and a credible threat of violence.

12 8. Bates first known uninvited visit to Petitioner's residence in Los Angeles was in
13 early-2009, at which time Bates states she was not allowed to enter or to talk to her "husband",
14 falsely referring to Petitioner's deceased father. On that first occasion when she sought entrance
15 to Petitioner's property, the police were called and Bates was advised to leave and not return,
16 which she acknowledges. Bates second known uninvited visit to Petitioner's residence was in
17 September 2009, and that, on that occasion, the police transported Bates away from the property
18 and questioned her, but she was released. After unsuccessfully attempting to gain entrance to
19 Petitioner's property, Bates sought additional means to contact Petitioner, and she left multiple
20 telephone messages and sent multiple written letters to Petitioner. (Jackson Decl., ¶12; Seagal
21 Decl., ¶¶6-7).

22 9. Bates was arrested at Petitioner's home on July 14, 2010, which was the third
23 known time that Bates went to Petitioner's residence and sought to gain access to him and his
24 home. (Jackson Decl., ¶6, Exhibit "A" - a copy of the LAPD police Arrest Complaint; Seagal
25 Decl., ¶8). Bates admits to law enforcement that she specifically went to Petitioner's home to live
26 there and retrieve her personal belongings, believing that she is married to Petitioner's (deceased)
27 father and that the property is her home. On the night of her arrest, on July 14th, Bates laid-in-
28 wait out side of Petitioner's home for an opportunity to gain access to his property and his home.

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1 When a car drove through the security gate at the property, Bates came running from out of hiding
2 in the shadows outside the gate, rushed through the gate and ran approximately 200-feet up the
3 driveway to Petitioner's residence. (Jackson Decl., ¶¶6, 13, Exh. "A"; Zhe Decl., ¶5). Once
4 inside the gate, Bates picked up two large fist-sized rocks. When blocked from access to the house
5 by Petitioner's groundskeeper, Mr. Zhe, Bates repeatedly stated to Mr. Zhe that the property was
6 hers and that she wanted to contact Steven Seagal, then intentionally aimed one of the large rocks
7 at the window of the house and threw it, shattering the window. As Mr. Zhe tried to block Bates'
8 access to the home and remove her from the property, Bates physically attacked Mr. Zhe,
9 forcefully kicking him twice, in the groin and on his shin, causing a two-inch confusion on his leg.
10 (Jackson Decl., ¶13; Zhe Decl., ¶6).

11 10. The police were called, and Bates was still at Petitioner's residence when they
12 arrived, and was found sitting on-top of a rock wall at the gate, seeking access. Bates was
13 ultimately arrested. While the police spoke with Bates, she stated her delusional belief that she
14 was married to Petitioner's father, who has been deceased for approximately twenty-years, and
15 stated that she has lived at Petitioner's residence with Petitioner's father for over twenty-years,
16 and that the property is hers. (Zhe Decl., ¶7; Jackson Decl., ¶6, 9, 14, Exh. "A").

17 11. After Bates' arrest, she was interviewed by a detective of the Los Angeles Threat
18 Management Unit who asked her plans for after she is released from custody. In response, Bates
19 stated to the detective and repeatedly expressed her desire to make contact with Petitioner, whom
20 Bates continues to (delusionally) believe she is related by marriage to his father, and to return to
21 Petitioner's residence, which she continues to (delusionally) believe is also her residence. (Jackson
22 Decl., ¶14). Bates's fixation, obsessive conduct and stalking has caused Petitioner to become
23 seriously alarmed, annoyed and harassed, and has caused him, as would any reasonable person,
24 to suffer distress with fear for the safety of his family and those around them. (Seagal Decl., ¶¶10-
25 11).

26 12. Bates has displayed a compulsive and unrelenting desire to make contact with
27 Petitioner, and exhibited her irrational and delusional belief that she knows him, is a member of
28 his family, and that she does and has for twenty-years resided at Petitioner's residence. Bates is

1 clearly a person obsessed with Petitioner and his family, and Bates admittedly will not stop
2 stalking and attempting to communicate with Petitioner until, or unless, ordered by a court of law.

3 13. Bates's erratic, unpredictable, harassing and stalking conduct has continued and
4 escalated. Bates's increasingly aggressive and harassing stalking conduct has caused Petitioner
5 to fear for the personal safety of his family and anyone around them. As a result of Bates's
6 conduct, the LAPD was notified of the incidents described hereinabove. Petitioner was advised
7 by the LAPD Threat Management Unit to advance this Petition/Application for Orders Prohibiting
8 Harassment, because, based upon Bates's history and own statements and conduct, unless Bates's
9 harassing and stalking conduct is prevented by order of this Court for the maximum period, and
10 pending hearing on this Petition, the said conduct will continue, and escalate.

11
12 **APPLICATION FOR AN OSC RE TRO AND FOR INJUNCTION SHOULD BE**
13 **GRANTED TO RESTRAIN BATES FROM FURTHER HARASSING CONDUCT**

14 14. Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 527.6, a person who has suffered
15 harassment, such as by stalking, may seek a restraining order and an injunction prohibiting
16 harassment. Code Civ. Proc. § 527.6(a). It provides, in pertinent part:

17 "(a) A person who has suffered harassment as defined in subdivision (b) may seek
18 a temporary restraining order and an injunction prohibiting harassment as provided
19 in this section.

20 (b) For the purposes of this section, "harassment" is unlawful violence, a credible
21 threat of violence, or a knowing and willful course of conduct directed at a
22 specific person that seriously alarms, annoys, or harasses the person, and that
23 serves no legitimate purpose. The course of conduct must be such as would cause
24 a reasonable person to suffer substantial emotional distress, and must actually cause
25 substantial emotional distress to the plaintiff."
26 ***

27 "(1) 'Unlawful violence' is any assault or battery, or stalking as prohibited in
28 Section 646.9 of the Penal Code, but shall not include lawful acts of self-defense
or defense of others.

(2) 'Credible threat of violence' is a knowing and willful statement or course of
conduct that would place a reasonable person in fear for his or her safety, or the
safety of his or her immediate family, and that serves no legitimate purpose.

(3) 'Course of conduct' is a pattern of conduct composed of a series of acts over
a period of time, however short, evidencing a continuity of purpose, including
following or stalking an individual, making harassing telephone calls to an
individual, or sending harassing correspondence to an individual by any means,

1 including, but not limited to, the use of public or private mails, interoffice mail,
2 fax, or computer e-mail. Constitutionally protected activity is not included within
the meaning of "course of conduct."

3 Code Civ. Proc. § 527.6 (emphasis added).

4 15. Bates's conduct directed at Petitioner and his family constitutes harassment and
5 unlawful threat of violence by stalking and a willful course of conduct directed against Petitioner,
6 which has seriously alarmed, annoyed and/or harassed him and which serves no legitimate
7 purpose. CCP § 527.6(b). (Seagal Decl., ¶¶10-11). It is clear from Bates's irrational and
8 delusional conduct and statements, and her unlawful and stalking conduct, that unless restrained
9 by court order for the maximum period and pending hearing on this Petition, Bates's conduct will
10 continue and likely increase and maybe worsen. As a result of Bates's continuing and heightened
11 stalking and harassing behavior, including her recent actions of showing-up at and trespassing at
12 Petitioner's residence, and physical attack of Petitioner's employee and vandalism of Petitioner's,
13 and trying to insert herself into Petitioner's private and personal life, Petitioner has real and
14 reasonable fears for the safety of his family and those around them.

15 16. The injunctive relief sought herein should be granted for a period of three (3) years.
16 Such a period is authorized by Code of Civil Procedure § 527.6(d). The three (3) year period is
17 necessary in order to protect Petitioner and his family from Bates' long-time obsession and
18 escalating fixation now manifesting into harassing, unprivileged and threatening conduct.

19 17. The scope of the injunctive relief sought hereunder is authorized under Code of
20 Civil Procedure § 527.6. This section provides for the granting of injunctive relief against any
21 harassing course of conduct provided there is no legitimate reason for the conduct and there are
22 no constitutional rights being violated. Code Civ. Proc. § 527.6.

23 18. Clearly there are no constitutional rights at issue in this case where the injunction
24 is sought to restrain Bates from potentially physically assaulting people who would deny her access
25 to Petitioner, or to restrain Bates going near or into Petitioner's private home, and from speaking
26 with or attempting to communicate with him, either directly or through third-parties.

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1 19. Bates's conduct is repeated and ongoing in nature and constitutes a course of
 2 conduct that is harmful and damaging to Petitioner. This is precisely the type of conduct which
 3 the injunctive relief provisions of Code of Civil Procedure § 527.6 where designed to prevent.
 4 See, *Ensworth v. Mullvain* (1990) 224 Cal.App.4th 1105, 274 Cal.Rptr. 447 (injunctive relief
 5 under this section was granted to a psychologist against a former patient who knowingly and
 6 willfully engaged in a course of conduct that seriously annoyed, or harassed plaintiff); *Volpicelli*
 7 *v. Jared Sidney Torrance Memorial Hospital* (1980) 109 Cal.App.3d 242, 167 Cal.Rptr. 610
 8 (injunctive relief granted upon evidence of ongoing wrongful actions).

9 CONCLUSION

10 For the forgoing reasons, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court immediately grant
 11 the injunctive relief being sought herein in order to protect him against Bates's on-going harassing
 12 and stalking conduct.

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Los Angeles Superior

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1 6. It is my understanding that the first two known occasions of which Ms. Bates
2 appeared uninvited at the security-gate surrounding my property, and sought to enter my property,
3 was in approximately early-2009 and again on September 26, 2009. On both occasions, Ms. Bates
4 was stopped, and was unable to gain access to my residence. On both occasions the authorities
5 were called, and Ms. Bates was removed by the authorities.

6 7. After the known occasions of which Ms. Bates appeared at my property in 2009,
7 it was public knowledge that I was away from my California residence, including on location for
8 many months in Louisiana for the filming of my television series "Steven Seagal: Lawman".
9 During the time while I was out-of-state, Ms. Bates repeatedly sought to contact me and
10 communicate with me. Ms. Bates repeatedly called and left multiple messages and sent multiple
11 written letters to me at my production location in Louisiana.

12 8. On the night of July 14, 2010, in furtherance of her obvious on-going delusional
13 compulsion to gain access to me, my home and my personal life, Ms. Bates appeared on a third
14 known occasion uninvited at my property. I am informed that Ms. Bates, in pursuit of an
15 opportunity to gain access to me and my home, laid-in-wait in the shadows outside the security
16 gate surrounding my property; and when an employee, who was house-sitting, opened the main
17 driveway gate for vehicle access, Ms. Bates ignored the gate and security fence and forced her
18 way onto my property without permission. I further understand that Ms. Bates then physically
19 attacked my employee as he sought to prevent her access to my home, and, during the attack, also
20 proceeded to throw one of two fist sized rocks in her hands through a window of my home.

21 9. Ms. Bates was arrested as a result of her trespass, physical assault of my employee
22 and her destruction and vandalism of my home. I am aware that Ms. Bates has, in her
23 communications to me and at the time of her arrest, continually stated false and delusional beliefs
24 that she married my father and resides at my residence. I understand that, despite Ms. Bates being
25 informed that her beliefs are false and that she is to cease any attempts to contact me or to come
26 to my home, she has reaffirmed her continued desire and intent to seek to contact me and to gain
27 access to my home.



1 10. Due to Ms. Bates' delusional compulsion and on-going and increasingly harassing,
 2 stalking and now violent and destructive conduct, I have been subjected to a course of conduct
 3 which has and is seriously alarming, annoying and harassing me, and extremely distressing.

4 11. As set forth in my declaration by submission of my Request for Orders to Stop
 5 Harassment, the Attachment A thereto, and related pleadings and exhibits, I respectfully request
 6 that the Court make an order prohibiting and restraining Angela Bates from coming near me, my
 7 residence, my workplaces, or wherever I am, and from my employees, and prohibit any other type
 8 of harassment and any attempted communications, whether directly or indirectly.

9 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the
 10 foregoing is true and correct.

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 15 STEVEN SEAGAL



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1 5. On or about July 14, 2010, a female adult individual by the name of Angela Rain
2 Bates was arrested, and, after arraignment, she was held on a court ordered psychiatric evaluation
3 related to her stalking of actor Steven Seagal, including trespass at his residence, vandalism of his
4 residence, and physical assault of an employee who was at the residence as he sought to prevent
5 her access. I am the lead detective assigned to the matter and investigation with regard to Angela
6 Bates. During the course of my investigation and preparation of a police report, file and
7 evaluation with regard to Angela Bates' apparent compulsive stalking of Mr. Seagal, I personally
8 interviewed Ms. Bates.

9 6. Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is, to the best of my knowledge, a true and correct
10 copy (with private information/addresses redacted) of the LAPD police "Arrest Complaint,"
11 Booking No. 2403615, and corresponding "Investigative Report", both related to the incidents of
12 July 14, 2010 with regard to Ms. Bates' arrest for Felony Vandalism (Penal C. 594(b)(1)) of Mr.
13 Seagal's residence, and requested additional filings for Criminal Stalking (Penal C. 646.9(a)),
14 Trespass (Penal C. 602.5) and Battery (Penal C. 2439a).

15
16 **Current Delusional Schizophrenia and/or Mental Illness**

17 7. Through my personal interview of Ms. Bates in the course of my current
18 investigation, and review of police records, I am informed and believe that Ms. Bates suffers from
19 mental illnesses, including from delusional schizophrenia. While interviewing Ms. Bates, she has
20 stated to me that she believes that she personally knows Mr. Seagal and his family, and that she
21 is a member of that family, as further set forth below.

22 8. While interviewing Ms. Bates, who was born in England and later lived in Toronto,
23 Canada, she provided me with information that she believes about her background, much of which
24 I have found to be false and delusional in nature. Ms. Bates stated to me that she believes that she
25 married "Steven Seagal Sr.," the name she used to refer to Mr. Seagal's father, in 1970 in
26 Toronto, Canada, when she states she and Mr. Seagal's father were both 16 1/2 years-old -- when
27 Mr. Seagal himself would have been approximately 18-years-old. I understand that Mr. Seagal's
28 father's true name is not Steven Seagal or Steven Seagal Sr. Ms. Bates stated to me that she

1 believes that her "husband", referring to Mr. Seagal's father, had worked as a policeman in
 2 Toronto. Ms. Bates stated that she was originally from England, but that her husband was able
 3 to get her Canadian citizenship as a gift. Ms. Bates further stated that her maiden name was
 4 "Bates" but falsely states that she is legally known as "Angela Seagal".

5 9. Ms. Bates further stated that she moved out to Los Angeles with Mr. Seagal's father
 6 approximately 25 to 30 years ago. Ms. Bates further stated that she has had no contact with her
 7 husband for a long time, approximately 18 months, stating that she had gone away on a holiday,
 8 to Canada and England, and has not been able to see or talk to her husband since her return. I
 9 understand that Mr. Seagal's father's passed-away almost twenty-years-ago. Ms. Bates further
 10 delusionally stated to me that she lived with her husband in the residence, Mr. Seagal's residence,
 11 until the time when she went on holiday less than two-years-ago, and that she and her husband are
 12 the true owners of the house.

13 10. Ms. Bates' statements and conduct exhibits classic symptoms of delusional
 14 Schizophrenia.

15
 16 **Multi-Year Escalating Fixation with and Stalking of Mr. Seagal**

17 11. Through my interview of Ms. Bates, I am informed and understand that Ms. Bates
 18 has a long-time delusional fixation on and obsession of Mr. Seagal and his family. Ms. Bates
 19 obsession has included an on-going delusional compulsion in which she has repeatedly sought to
 20 have personal contact with and insert herself into Mr. Seagal's and his families' lives. Ms. Bates
 21 has further stated, and admitted, that she has sought to make personal contact with Mr. Seagal and
 22 his family since at least early-2009, admitting that she has personally gone to Mr. Seagal's
 23 residence in Los Angeles on at least three occasions, and admitting that she sent multiple written
 24 letters or messages to Mr. Seagal at his residence. I am informed that Ms. Bates also called and
 25 left multiple telephone messages and sent multiple letters to Mr. Seagal at his production location
 26 in Louisiana.

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1 12. Ms. Bates admitted that her first visit to Mr. Seagal's residence in Los Angeles was
 2 approximately a year-ago, and stated she was not allowed to enter or to talk to her "husband",
 3 falsely referring to Mr. Seagal's deceased father. Ms. Bates acknowledged that, on that first
 4 occasion when she sought entrance to Mr. Seagal's property, the police were called and she was
 5 advised to leave and not return, and that she was released. Ms. Bates admitted that her second
 6 visit to Mr. Seagal's residence was approximately six-months or more ago, and that, on that
 7 occasion, the police transported her away from the property and questioned her, but she was not
 8 arrested and was released. Ms. Bates further admitted that, after unsuccessfully attempting to gain
 9 entrance to the property, she left multiple messages for Mr. Seagal at his residence, but "never
 10 received a response."

11 13. Ms. Bates has admitted to me that her arrest at Mr. Seagal's home on July 14, 2010
 12 was the third time that she has gone to Mr. Seagal's residence and sought to gain access to him
 13 and his home. Ms. Bates has admitted to me that she specifically went to Mr. Seagal's home to
 14 live there and retrieve her personal belongings, believing that she is married to Mr. Seagal's
 15 (deceased) father and that the property is her home. Ms. Bates has admitted to me that she laid-in-
 16 wait out-side of Mr. Seagal's home for an opportunity to gain access to his property and his home,
 17 stating that she eventually entered the property when a car drove through the security gate. Ms.
 18 Bates states that once inside the gate, she picked up two-rocks, and tried to warn Mr. Zhe that the
 19 property was hers and that she wanted to contact Steven Seagal. Ms. Bates further admitted that
 20 she intentionally aimed the rock at the window of the house and threw it. She stated that Mr. Zhe
 21 tried remove her from "her property" and that she advised him to contact Steven Seagal several
 22 times because it was "her property." Ms. Bates further admitted that she pushed Mr. Zhe to get
 23 him off balance, and then she attacked him, kicking him twice. Ms. Bates' conduct resulted in
 24 arrest and a mental evaluation, and criminal charges are pending against her.

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
1 14. After Ms. Bates' arrest, I interviewed her and asked Ms. Bates her plans for after
2 she is released from custody. In response, Ms. Bates stated to me and repeatedly expressed to me
3 her desire to make contact with Mr. Seagal, whom she (delusionally) believes she is related by
4 marriage to his father, and to return to Mr. Seagal's residence, which she (delusionally) believes
5 is also her residence.

6 15. During my investigations I have interviewed numerous suspects in regards to their
7 methods of operation, as well as numerous victims, in terms of the process of mental anguish they
8 have endured, and am I am trained in stalking threat assessment. It is my professional opinion that
9 Ms. Bates is stalking Mr. Seagal and his family, and that she poses a security concern, credible
10 threat of violence, and imminent danger to the health and welfare of Mr. Seagal's family and
11 anyone at his residence or around him. My opinion and evaluation is based on my experience as
12 a long-time veteran and detective with the LAPD, and member of the LAPD TMU, participation
13 in Threat Management Conferences and threat assessment education and expertise, and, among
14 other things, my face-to-face meeting with, discussion with and evaluation of Angela Bates, my
15 knowledge of the facts related to Ms. Bates's current stalking and obsessive attention towards Mr.
16 Seagal and his family, and my review of the pertinent facts contained in the Application for TRO
17 and Injunction Against Harassment in the matter *Seagal v. Bates*.

18 16. It is my professional opinion that it is imperative as a tool for law enforcement to
19 help prevent Ms. Bates' stalking and harassment of Mr. Seagal and his family, that a civil TRO
20 and an Injunction Against Harassment be issued against Ms. Bates.

21 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the
22 foregoing is true and correct.

On 07-14-10, at approximately 2130 hours, my partner Officer Ikeda#35765, and I Officer Lopez#37646, were assigned [REDACTED] WLA Patrol. We were in full uniform in a marked black and white police vehicle. We responded to a radio call of a battery suspect there now at [REDACTED] Rd. The comments read, "Susp Angela Bates [REDACTED] threw rock into window, assaulted worker at location wishes to press charges, No R/O on file. Incident#100714005491.

INVESTIGATION:

Upon our arrival we observed a F/W (later identified as deft-Bates) sitting on a rock wall on the left side of the front gate. Upon arrival we were met by Vict#2-(Zhe). Zhe advised us that he is Vict#1's-(Seagal) house-sitter at [REDACTED]. Zhe advised us that he stepped out [REDACTED] at approximately 2030 hours, when he returned at approximately 2045 he opened the front gate at which point, the Deft-(Bates) who was hiding in the shadows ran approximately 200 feet up the driveway to victim-1's residence. Zhe observed Bates pick up two fist sized rocks, one in each hand. Zhe asked Bates "What are you doing?" Bates replied, "This is my house." Zhe saw Bates throw one of the rocks at the living room window with her right hand, shattering the window. Zhe asked Bates "Why did you break the window?" Bates ignored Zhe. Zhe facing Bates, [REDACTED] attempt to escort her off the premises. Bates kicked Zhe twice, once in the groin and once on the shin with her right foot. Zhe was able to escort Bates off the premises and close the gates. Zhe contacted Vict-1.

Victim-1 (Seagal) was contacted via telephone by Officer Lopez. Seagal advised Officer Lopez that this was third time Bates has gone to his residence. Seagal stated Bates is currently stalking him [REDACTED]. Seagal wants to press additional charges of Stalking and Trespass. Seagal told () officers that he has no relationship with the deft and is not related to her in any way.

Deft-(Bates) spontaneously stated, she was married to Steven Seagal's father and has lived at that residence for over 20 years. Bates stated "There is no crime. I threw the rock at my own window. It isn't a crime to break my own window." Bates refused to give us her real name. Bates continuously stated that her name was Angela Seagal. Officers verified her real name through papers kept on her person.

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ARREST:

Bates was arrested for 594(b)(1)PC Felony Vandalism and transported to WLA Station for booking approval.

BOOKING:

Bates was booked for 594(b)(1)PC Felony Vandalism at Van Nuys Jail on approval from Sgt. Segee# 26999 WLA Watch Commander.

INJURIES:

Bates was seen by the Van Nuys Dispensary, Dr Arabo, for her sunburn prior to booking.

Victim-2(Zhe) had 2" contusion on his right shin. Zhe refused RA and would get his own medical treatment if necessary.
